- Design lead for the remodel, expansion, and modernization of an historically significant 1970's senior living tower in a dense urban setting in Austin, Texas. Non-profit owner sought a budget-smart solution to double the number of units to about 500: views, orientation, user experience and respect for the character of the existing international-style buildings were primary drivers in the design of this project.
- Managed design effort for a two-city-block sized mixed-use project to be built in Dubai, UAE. 1 million SF of residential and 200k SF of retail fit into a new 300 acre town center; a focus on sustainability, walkability, and social connectivity for the middle class Emirati population informed design decisions.
- Executed and directed design and planning efforts for mixed-use projects from Austin to North Carolina; retail, office, residential, cinema, and restaurants blended into dense pedestrian-focused developments.
